-INLW Management Board Meeting

Resolution proposed by International Network of Liberal Women and adopted by L.I. Executive

Recognizing the many concerns e-mailed to the INLW by Iraqi Women,

-noting the removal of Resolution 137 of the Iraqi constitution, which addressed women's rights and banned arbitrary divorce and polygamy, child custody and property inheritance,

the Executive Committee of Liberal International, convening in Kaoshiung, Taiwan, March 4-6 2004:

-calls on all Liberal International member parties to press their respective Governments to urge the Iraqi Government Council to propose an electoral system for the country, that ensures equality of access, opportunity and participation in elections and decision-making and recognition of women's rights.
